

# 16th ANNUAL PAPILLION DAYS DUATHLON

**Sunday, June 18<sup>th</sup> 2017**

In an effort to reduce the amount of motor vehicle and bicycle interaction, it will be necessary to close or limit traffic around Walnut Creek Lake and Recreation Area. Based on where you live or where you may be traveling the morning of Sunday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, please note the following roadway restrictions:

- Walnut Creek Area will be closed from 6:00-11:00 am.
- Walnut Creek Campgrounds - no vehicular traffic will be allowed into the south entrance from Schram Road from 7:00 am – 10:30 am, except for race participants and spectators prior to start of the race.
- Schram Road from Turkey Road to 96<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed from 7:30-10:30 am.
  - For those of you living in cul-de-sacs on the north side of Schram Road we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your cul-de-sacs with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this hour time period. Should you need to leave your cul-de-sac while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go east on Schram Road. Staff will be on hand to guide you where to go. Please watch for bikers traveling both directions on Schram Road.
- 96<sup>th</sup> Street from Schram Road to HWY 370 will be closed from 7:30-10:30 am.
  - For those of you living in cul-de-sacs on the west side of 96<sup>th</sup> Street we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your cul-de-sacs with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this 3 hour time period. Should you need to leave your cul-de-sac while the barricades are in place we ask two things;
    - Motor vehicle traffic will be guided east to Lake Vista Drive. Staff will be on hand to guide you where to go.
    - Please watch for bicyclists traveling on 96<sup>th</sup> street. Some of them will be traveling at a very high rate of speed.
- HWY 370 Southern East Bound Lane will be closed from 7:00-10:30 am.
- 108<sup>th</sup> Street from the southern must entrance to Papillion-LaVista South High School to HWY 370 (north bound lanes) will be closed from 7:30-10:30 am.
  - For residents living in the South Brook Neighborhood, we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your neighborhood with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this hour time period. Should you need to leave your neighborhood while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; please watch for bikers traveling both directions in the north bound lanes on 108<sup>th</sup> street.

Please use caution and watch for cyclists and spectators throughout the Walnut Creek Recreation Area between the hours of 7:30 am and 11:00 am.
