



Sunday, May 21st 2017

Due to the size and location of this event, it will be necessary to close or limit traffic throughout various parts of the Papillion community for safety reasons. Based on where you live or where you may be traveling the morning of May 21st, please note the following roadway restrictions:

- Walnut Creek Recreation Area will be closed from 6:00-11:00 am.
- Walnut Creek Campgrounds - no vehicular traffic will be allowed into the south entrance from Schram Road from 6:00 am – 11:00 am. Anyone already in the campground will be able to exit if needed during the race. Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go south on Turkey Road or east on Schram Road. Please watch for runners traveling west on Schram Road.
- 108th Street north bound lane from Schram Road to HWY 370 will be closed from 6:30-8:07 am.
 - For residents living in the South Brook Neighborhood, we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your neighborhood with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this hour time period. Should you need to leave your neighborhood while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to use the Edward Street entrance/exit. The south bound lane will be open and the center lane will be open for northbound traffic. Please watch for runners traveling north and south on 108th street.
- HWY 370 southern most east bound lane from 108th Street to 96th Street will be closed from 6:30-8:23 am.
- 96th Street south bound lane from HWY 370 to Gold Coast Road will be closed from 6:30-8:30 am.
- 96th Street south bound lane from Gold Coast Road to Schram Road will be closed from 6:30-10:33 am.
 - For those of you living in cul-de-sacs on the west side of 96th Street we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your cul-de-sacs with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this hour time period. Should you need to leave your cul-de-sac while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go north on 96th Street. Staff will be on hand to guide you where to go. Please watch for runners traveling south on 96th street.
- Schram Road west bound lane from 96th Street to Turkey Road will be closed from 6:30-11:00 am.
 - For those of you living in cul-de-sacs on the north side of Schram Road we apologize for any inconvenience. While it is our hope to minimize the amount of traffic into and out of your cul-de-sacs with signs and barricades, we realize you may need to come and go during this hour time period. Should you need to leave your cul-de-sac while the barricades are in place we ask one thing; Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed to go east on Schram Road. Staff will be on hand to guide you where to go. Please watch for runners traveling west on Schram Road.
- Residents of Santa Fe Circle will have restricted access in and out of the cul-de-sac from 6:30 am to 10:10 am. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with traffic; runners will be entering/exiting the trail on 96th street from under the tunnel at Hwy 370 in this neighborhood. Extreme caution will be required.
- 6th Street (Cornhusker Road) east bound lane from 96th Street to N. Jackson Street will be closed 6:30-9:18 am.
- N. Jackson Street from 6th Street (Cornhusker Road) to N. Adams Street will be closed 6:30-9:26 am
- N. Adams Street from N. Jackson to First Street will be closed from 6:30-10:30 am.
- First Street from N. Adams Street to 84th Street will be closed from 6:30-9:26 am.
- 84th Street western most south bound lane from 1st Street to Lincoln Street will be closed from 6:30-9:28 am
